





Aaron has had a longtime dream of owning his own restaurant and he and Victoria decided it was time to become owners and came across Chick'N Max, a newer concept restaurant based in Wichita, Kansas. They said they chose this concept since it is a truly unique chicken sandwich and a premium product at a reasonable price.

The restaurant offers 11 sandwiches to go along with tenders and almond wood smoked chicken. Aaron's favorite is the Nashville hot and their bestselling sandwich is their chicken and waffles to the max.

Chick'N Max has a lot of sides to choose from and the favorites tend to be the white cheddar macaroni and cheese and the deviled egg potato salad. Lastly, they make most of the sauces in-house, and strongly recommend both the buttermilk garlic sauce and the sriracha hot honey.

The restaurant also offers catering, and yes, they can cater to Grand Central Park! Make sure you try them out! They are located 15 minutes from GCP just north on I-45.




